- Senior Membership—Kupuna** 65 years old with at least 20 years Active Membership. \$ 7.00
- Life Membership—E Ola Mau** is open to all membership levels and is a one-time payment. \$400.00
- Club silk lei**—part of the club uniform, it is required of all members and received at the time of your installation. \$ 20.00

The official club uniform is a white mu'umu'u for women and a white short or long-sleeved shirt with white pants for men, white shoes and silk lei to be worn at appropriate Club events, as well as related council and association activities. We also have an alternate uniform (available directly from Nake'u) which is a purple design on a printed fabric). The alternate uniform shirts for men may be worn with black or dark grey slacks and black shoes.
