## **New Member Responsibilities**

First year's dues and cost of the club silk lei should be submitted with your completed application after which annual fees are assessed. After June, first year's dues are reduced 50%.

The official club uniform is a white muʻumuʻu for women and a white short or long-sleeved shirt with white pants for men, white shoes and silk lei to be worn at appropriate Club events, as well as related council and association activities. We also have an alternate uniform (available directly from Nakeʻu) which is a purple design on a printed fabric). The alternate uniform shirts for men may be worn with black or dark grey slacks and black shoes.
