- 3. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 for high school students/undergraduates and 3.3 for graduate students
- 4. Demonstrate academic and leadership potential

Additional Requirements

Applicants must submit the following documents along with their application:

- 1. Verification of Hawaiian ancestry (i.e. copy of birth certificate, Ho'oulu Data Center letter)
- 2. A transcript of first semester grades
- 3. A resume & letter of recommendation
- 4. Submit an essay to the following question:

What Hawaiian issue influenced your decision to pursue your course of study in college/university?

If you currently receive a PKHCC scholarship, please submit:

- 1. This application to renew your scholarship;
- 2. A transcript of your spring semester grades at the end of the school year.
- 3. A reflection statement of your community service work.
